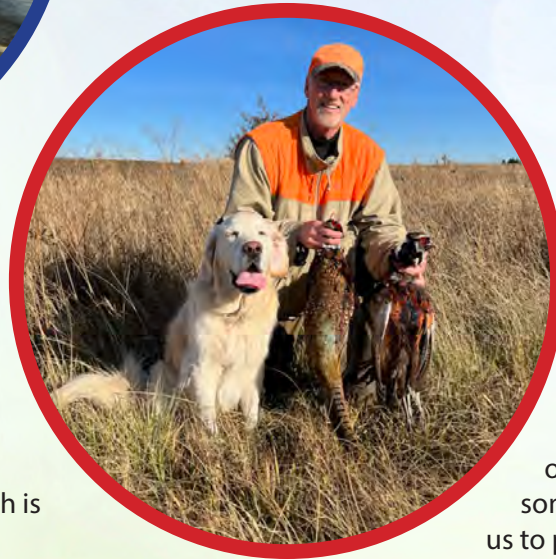
# CEO MESSAGE

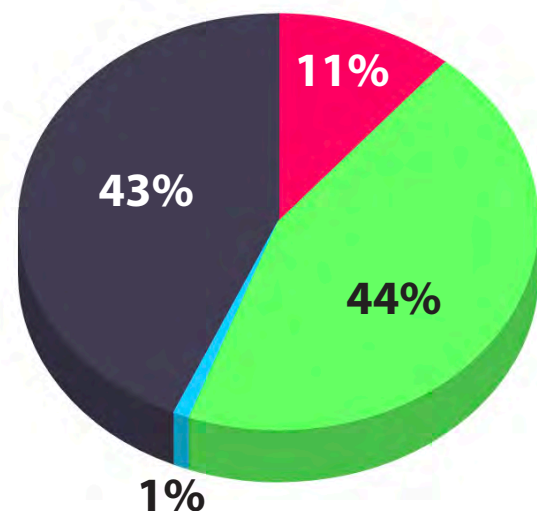

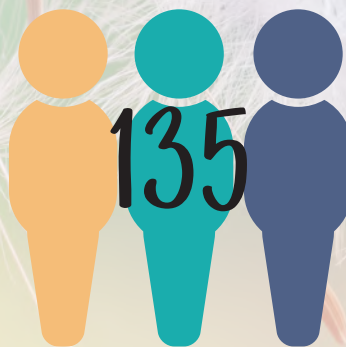
